

# WHAT IS THE STUDY BRIDGE?



The Study Bridge is a program run by the Goethe-Institut in partnership with the German universities in the University Alliance Ruhr (Ruhr University Bochum, TU Dortmund University, and the University of Duisburg-Essen) and the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD).

The program is geared towards students with aboveaverage performance in the STEM subjects of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics, who have German language skills, and would like to study in Germany.

Targeted preparation in the areas of language, subject-specific terminology, and learning culture in the U.S. and Germany makes it possible for Study Bridge participants to be granted direct access to study at one of the partner universities after graduating from high school.
